Achievements

■ **Pittsburg Tank and Tower Co.** here has been certified as a Drug-Free Workplace by the Kentucky Department of Workers' Claims.

The company is the fifth employer in the state to achieve that designation. The program was created by the 2008 General Assembly.

Receiving the designation requires an employer to provide training for employees and supervisors and to test employees for breath alcohol and 11 narcotics (although Pittsburg screens for 12) as part of random drug tests, pre-employment screening, when there is reasonable cause or in the aftermath of an injury or accident. It also must provide an employee assistance program.

The certification applies to the Pittsburg headquarters and plant in Henderson as well as at other locations around the country. The company's vice president of loss prevention is Donald McConnell.
